Important information about Dental Nursing qualifications and apprenticeships can be found on the 4238 web page under the Documents tab and clicking on Centre documents.

City & Guilds is delighted to inform you that the new 4238-12 Level 3 Extended Diploma in Dental Nursing is now open for registrations and is also included in the Learning Aims Database with LARS number **60370993**. This qualification is ONLY available in England and meets the requirements of the recently published Dental Nurse (Integrated) apprenticeship standard. Centres approved for the 5234-01 may complete the Fast Track Approval form to gain approval and must also complete an EPA application for, which can be found on the Walled Garden.

All new apprenticeship starts from 02 December 2020 must use the integrated assessment plan ST0113/AP03 and register on the integrated qualification 4238-12.

The EPA pack which accompanies to 4238-12 Qualification Handbook will be available in February 2021.

4238-03

9752 End Point Assessment products

Both the 9752-12 (version 1) and 9752-22 (version 2) products will remain open for registration to ensure that apprentices are able to access End Point Assessment for starts prior to 02 December 2020.

5234-01

It is intended that the 5234-01 qualification will be closed for registrations on 31 July 2021.

The replacement standalone qualification 4238-03 is intended to be available for registrations in March 2021. The availability of both the 4238-03 and 5234-01 at the same time is to ensure that there is a funded qualification available until funding applications can be processed, Qualifications Wales designation can be applied for and CCEA accreditation can be confirmed to enable the qualification to be available in Northern Ireland.
