OVERVIEW

• What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the knowledge and skills that learners will need in order to confirm their competence in the areas of maternity and paediatric support when working as healthcare assistants in these settings.

- Safeguarding and duty of care
- Good practice in handling information

All learners will complete the mandatory units and will then be able to select from a wide range of optional units. This will enable them to tailor their learning to the needs of their work role.

Optional areas covered include:

- Administration of medicines
- Supporting individuals with behavioural changes and health choices
- Supporting children, young people, carers and parents
- Care planning for babies and parents
- Team work
- Monitoring of own performance
