What does this qualification cover?	The Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support is a competence based qualification which means that it covers the knowledge and skill that are required to work in a particular healthcare support role, such as senior healthcare assistant or senior healthcare support worker in health settings. The settings include: • Adult Nursing Support • Maternity Support • Children and Young People • Theatre Support • Mental Health • Allied Healthcare Profession Therapy Support
	You will usually work under the direct supervision of a registered health professional such as a registered nurse.
	This qualification consists of mandatory units covering core knowledge and skills competencies with optional specialisms which can be combined in flexible ways to reflect the real working context of different learners.

The assessment of the qualification mostly takes place in your real work environment whilst you carry out the day to day activities of your job. This means that you are also proving you work to a nationally recognised level at the same time as doing your job.

Occasionally you may be asked to complete a project, assignment or to answer questions which can be assessed outside of your workplace.

In this qualification there is a unit covering Study Skills where you will be required to complete an assignment.

WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO? This qualification is ideal for you if you are working in a Why choose this qualification healthcare setting and wish to develop your skills and over similar qualifications? knowledge to a level which demonstrates that you are competent as a Senior Healthcare Support Worker. Delivery of the qualification can be flexible to meet your needs and assessment usually takes place in your place of work.
