What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers a range of topics directly related to the knowledge and skills needed to operate in the Pharmacy Services sector.

Areas covered are:

- Assist with the provision of a pharmacy service to meet individuals 'needs

- Contribute to the effectiveness of teams
- Receive prescriptions from individuals
- Assemble prescribed items
- Assist in the preparation of documentation, materials and other items for manufacture and assembly of medicinal products
- Maintain pharmaceutical stock
- Order routine pharmaceutical stock
- Receive pharmaceutical stock
- Maintain pharmaceutical stock
- Assist in the issuing of pharmaceutical stock
- Assist in the manufacture and assembly of medicinal products
- Prepare aseptic products
- Prepare documentation, materials, components and other items for the preparation of aseptic products
- Assist in the preparation of documentation, materials and other items for manufacture and assembly of medicinal products
- Undertake an in-process accuracy check of assembled prescribed items prior to the final accuracy check
- Assist in the issuing of prescribed item

All learners will cover the mandatory core and then will select optional units, allowing them to tailor their learning and acquire specific knowledge and skills, appropriate to different pharmacy services settings.
