### OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the required skills and knowledge for working in the Hospitality & Catering Industry. It is designed to meet the needs of learners who want a more flexible approach enabling them to achieve this qualification together with a cookery qualification. The focus for the learner is to understand the service side of the industry.

The following areas that can be covered within this qualification:

- Introduction to employability in the catering and hospitality industry
- Health and safety awareness for catering and hospitality
- Legislation in food and beverage service
- Understand menus
- Dealing with payments and bookings
- Food and beverage service skills
- Bar service skills
- Hot beverage skills
- Food safety in catering

Learners will complete the required units to achieve the qualification, but will have the choice of which units to undertake.

This is a Framework qualification.



- Who could take this qualification?

For learners who require an understanding of this side of the hospitality & catering industry. Learners will likely be on an additional cookery qualification as well.

This qualification is designed for learners who want to prepare for learning or training in the hospitality & catering sector or to progress on to an apprenticeship and/or into employment..

This qualification is suitable for anyone from 16 years old or over to take this qualification.

#### WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

This qualification could lead to jobs such as:

- Front of house/service
  - Restaurants
  - Hotels

The learner could progress into employment and undertake an apprenticeship, such as food and beverage service or professional cookery at level 2, or continue in further education achieving one of the following industry related qualifications. It is noted that in some cases their progression will be on to the full Diploma qualification at the same level.

- Level 2 Certificate in Professional Food and Beverage Service Skills
- Level 2 Certificate in Patisserie and Confectionery
- Level 1 Diploma in Professional Cookery
- Level 1 Diploma in Introduction to Professional Food & Beverage Service
