The qualifications are available at six levels, from beginner to advanced, and have been mapped to levels of the Common European Framework (CEF).

The IESOL notification of candidate result sheet must be included with the visa application.

The IESOL Diploma is made up of the IESOL and ISESOL qualifications together.

The Home Office is responsible for controlling the borders and managing immigration in the UK.

Individuals from outside the European Union wishing to come to or remain in the UK to work, study or join their spouses/ partners are required to provide evidence that they have an acceptable standard of English.

Only tests approved by the Home Office are accepted as part of the visa application process.

Expert level: holders of these certificates are eligible for employment within the Polish national educational system as teachers of English language in nearly all settings except for foreign language teacher training colleges.

Communicator level: recognised as meeting the minimum requirements for registration as English language teachers in the Polish national education system. The recognition applies to qualified teachers of subjects other than English language.

Holders of the certificates are considered to be qualified to

- (a) teach English to pre-school and forms 1-3 primary school students, provided that they also hold a young learners language teaching qualification or
- (b) teach subjects other than English via the medium of English language in bi-lingual schools.

First Class Pass at Achiever level, Communicator, Expert and Mastery levels are accepted for admission into undergraduate and graduate level courses conducted in the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

The Commission for Academic Accreditation (CAA) is the government-run institutional licensure and degree accreditation organisation for private universities and their academic programmes in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). It sets, among others, the standards for English language requirements for higher education studies.

CAA is a department of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and a member of the Arab Network for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ANQAHE).

All non-federal higher education institutions operating outside a free-zone in the UAE must have a license to operate and their academic programmes must be accredited before students may be admitted. Many institutions operating within a free-zone also submit themselves to the CAA for license and accreditation.

Institutions featured in this section are examples of universities and colleges which have recognised appropriate levels of IESOL and ISESOL as meeting the minimum English language requirements for admission to their degree or degree-linked programmes.

In some countries, the qualifications are also recognised as part of the graduation requirements, exempt candidates from attending compulsory language courses and/or taking otherwise compulsory language examinations.

For UK university recognitions, applicants are always required to achieve the recognised level in both IESOL and ISESOL.






