402	Conduct Priority and volume investigations
403	Interview suspects in relation to priority and volume investigations
404	Plan, implement and review an evidence-based preventative policing approach

Who is the Qualification for?

This qualification is for acting Police Officers to confirm their competence following initial training.

What does the qualification cover?

The Level 3 Diploma in Policing covers different aspects of priority and volume investigations, using police powers and dealing with victims, witnesses and suspects and assesses competence on the job to undertake the role of Police Officer

Progression routes?

This qualification creates a number of opportunities for progression. Learners may progress:

- To Police Sergeant, Inspector or above (dependent on successful completion of additional assessments and assessment Boards)
- into other specialist areas of policing.
