Who is the Qualification for?

This qualification is for individuals who are practising managers, such as Police Sergeants, within the police sector.

What does the qualification cover?

The Level 4 Certificate in Police First Line Management covers areas such as supervising investigations and responses to critical incidents, police operations, conducting briefings and debriefings and managing staff, with the main aim to support individuals to develop the specific knowledge, understanding and skills that are required within first line management in the police service.

Progression routes?
