OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers a very wide range of units relating to the land-based sector. To achieve the Award, you can choose to take one unit from 34 vocational units that could include units such as:

Safe and effective working practices in land-based industries
Industrial experience in land-based industries
Contribute to the establishment of plants
Carry out basic floristry tasks
Assist with maintaining the health and wellbeing of animals
Assist with the repair and maintenance of structures in the countryside
Introduction to wildlife and conservation
Animals in the wild and in society
Maintain the health of horses

This is a Framework qualification.

- Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification designed for?

The aim of the qualification is to provide bite sized learning (knowledge and skills) which could allow progression to further learning or qualifications (such as the Certificate in Land-based Studies) or into employment opportunities

There are no specific prior achievements required to take this qualification.

This qualification is suitable for learners both pre-16 and 16+.
