## **OVERVIEW**

The primary outcome of this qualification is to enable you to gain the specialist skills and knowledge to enter into employment within the dog grooming industry.

· What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the skills and knowledge required for working in the dog grooming industry. The content could enable you to become a dog groomer/stylist in a salon or a mobile unit.

Level 3 Certificate in Introductory Dog Grooming is a pre-requisite for the Level 3 Diploma.

The content of the qualification is very focussed on the specialist skills, knowledge and understanding needed to become a dog groomer. You need to take all of the following compulsory units (four will have already been taken through achieving the Level 3 Certificate):

Carry out styling and finishing of dogs
Assessment and planning of dog grooming work
Promote and maintain the health and wellbeing of animals
Health checking a dog by a dog groomer
Hand stripping a dog's coat
Style and trim a spaniel's coat
Style and trim a short-legged terrier's coat

In addition, you will take one of the following units:

Welcome, receive and care for visitors
Promote, monitor and maintain health, safety and security
Moving animals between locations
Handle payments from clients
Keep stock on sale at required levels in a retail environment









Plus one of the following units:

Style and trim a poodle's coat Style and trim a long-legged terrier or Schnauzer's coat

This is a Framework qualification.

• Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification designed for?

This qualification is a centre-based qualification designed to be taken in a College environment, or through a Training Provider. It reflects the specialist skills and knowledge needed to progress into employment within the dog grooming industry.

The Level 3 Certificate in Introductory Dog Grooming is a pre-requisite for the Level 3 Diploma.

You need to be 16 years old or over to take this qualification.

As a result of taking this qualification, you will have developed the specialist skills, knowledge and understanding to work within the dog grooming industry.
