10 Describe the process of removing a tick.

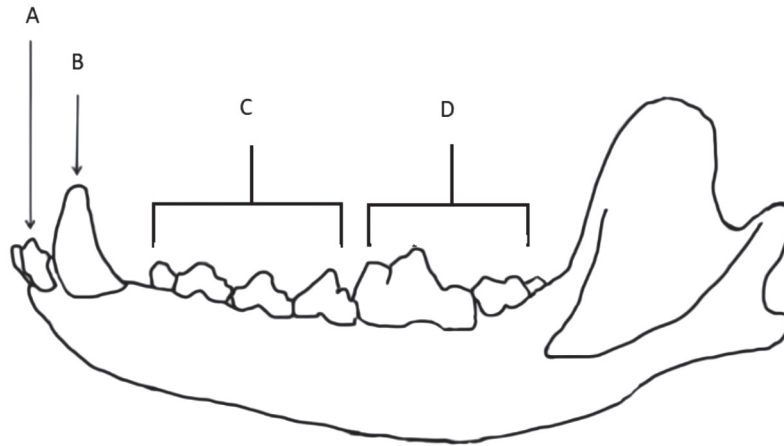
