Assessment is by completing specific activities which are externally set and internally assessed **plus** one synoptic multiple choice test covering the four units.

Candidates instructing or coaching others in a variety of settings.

No formal entry requirements although candidates should have a reasonable level of language and literacy skills in English and should also have a recognised qualification at the right level for the country in the subject that they are instructing and coaching

IVQ IN TEACHING TRAINING AND ASSESSING LEARNING

Advanced Diploma route 100 hours guided learning

Specialist Advanced Diploma route 150 hours guided learning

Core Route Assessment

Assessment is completed by specific activities which are externally set and internally assessed **plus** one summative multiple choice examination covering the five units, **plus** a holistic report.

Optional Route Assessment

All of the above as in the core route **plus** specific assessment activities **and** knowledge questions for the chosen optional units.
