WHO CAN HELP ME?



There are a number of people available to support you in the delivery and quality assurance of your qualifications:

Qualification Consultant (QC)

You will be allocated a QC for each of the qualifications you offer. This person is your first point of contact for queries and this is also the person who will visit your centre to quality assure candidate work, assessment and the IQA processes.

Portfolio Consultant

For each suite of qualifications, there is a Portfolio Consultant. This person supports QCs with queries and technical advice. The QC contacts them with any technical queries you raise and then passes the response back to you.

Centre Support

Every centre is given a contact in City & Guilds. This person can assist you with all general queries – i.e. not related to specific qualifications.
