Qualification aim

Qualification levels and definition Progression routes

These qualifications are for people working in, or looking to enter roles in learning and development. They are available to anyone working in learning and non accredited learning (where people may train and assess skills but do not assess for a qualification).

We also have a range of mini-qualifications that are made up of the units in the Learning and Development qualifications.

The Level 3 provides routes for learners to understand and work in the field of learning and development. The Level 4 provides routes for learners to understand and work in senior and managerial roles in the field of L&D.

The mini-qualifications are based on the units in the full L&D qualifications. This allows learners to achieve small qualifications as CPD or as entry into the profession.

Many of the units in these qualifications are 'nested' inside other qualifications. This is to assist learners to progress 'horizontally' at Level 3 by accumulating credits and gaining certified recognition for their learning and skills. Some of the L&D units are also available as optional units in the PTLLS and the CTLLS qualifications.

This makes it possible for Level 4 learners to progress from L&D to PTLLS and CTLLS with some units already completed.

Structure	There are three qualifications at Level 3 and two at Level 4.	The units can be achieved in any order and can be combined to fit the current role of the learner or to prepare them for the future. The L&D qualifications contains the Assessment and Internal Quality Assurance units. This makes it possible to qualify as an assessor and/or Internal Quality Assurer while undertaking these qualifications.
Assessment	Assessment in the knowledge-only route (6318-01 at Level 3) is by assignment if undertaken as a stand alone unit. Assessment of all other units is mainly by observation, portfolio and professional discussion.	The L&D qualifications contain the units of Assessment and Internal Quality Assurance qualifications as an option. This makes it possible to qualify as an Assessor and/or Internal Quality Assurer when undertaking the L&D qualifications. Assessments can be managed flexibly and holistic assessment is encouraged.
