What does this qualification cover?

- Health and safety within furniture and furnishing making environments
- Timber technology in furniture making
- Planning for career pathways in furniture and furnishing industries
- Professional responsibilities in furniture and furnishing making environments
- Sustainability in the timber trade

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification suitable for?

This qualification is suitable if you who wish to pursue a career in furniture installation within the furniture industry. There are no entry requirements for this qualification and it is suitable if you are above the age of 14.
