What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the advanced practical skills and knowledge required to work in furniture installation roles within the furniture industry

You will take the following mandatory units

- Health and safety within furniture and furnishing making environments
- Sustainability in the timber trade
- Design work for fitted furniture installation
- Site survey for furniture installation
- Supervision of fitted furniture installation

And then choose from the following optional units

- Produce drawings using CAD
- Research and product development in furniture making

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

This qualification is suitable if you wish to pursue a career in furniture installation roles within the furniture industry. Ideally you should already have completed the Level 2 Diploma in Furniture Installation (600/3201/7) qualification or have an understanding of basic furniture installation skills.

This qualification is suitable if you are aged 14 years old or over.

- Furniture Maker
- Furniture Installer
- Furniture Manufacturing Technician
