What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the advanced practical skills and knowledge required to work in furniture restoration roles within the furniture industry

You will take the following mandatory units

- Health and safety within furniture and furnishing making environments
- Assessment of furniture restoration
- Furniture restoration

And then choose from the following optional units

- Attaching doors, drawers and fittings in furniture making
- Hand finishing methods in furniture making
- Timber technology in furniture making
- Veneering methods in furniture making
- Assemble furniture components by hand
- Decorative veneering in furniture making
- Finishing methods in furniture restoration

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

This qualification is suitable if you wish to pursue a career in furniture restoration within the furniture industry. Ideally you should already have completed a Level 2 furniture related qualification or have an understanding of furniture production processes.

This qualification is suitable if you are aged 14 years old or over.

- Furniture Restorer
