What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the advanced practical skills and knowledge required to work on CNC machines within the wood machining industry

You will take the following mandatory units

- Health and safety within furniture and furnishing making environments
- Manufacturing wood-based components using CNC machines
- Sustainability in the timber trade
- Environmental management and waste management in woodmachining
- Manufacturing wood-based components using CNC machines
- Produce drawings using CAD
- Workflow management in wood machining

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

This qualification is suitable if you wish to pursue a career working on CNC machines in wood machining roles within the furniture industry. Ideally you should already have completed the Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Wood Machining (600/1976/1) qualification or have a basic understanding of wood machining skills.

This qualification is suitable if you are 14 years old or over.
