#### OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification provides the knowledge you need to gain an understanding of the warehouse and storage industry. It covers the following:

- procedures for checking the quality and quantity of goods received
- procedures for reporting and recording variations in deliveries or damage, breakages, quality or out-of-date items in storage
- procedures for packing items safely, securely and labelling correctly
- understanding health, safety and security when dispatching goods
- understanding documents and systems used for checking availability of stock
- understanding safety procedures when lifting heavy items.

This is a Framework qualification.

- Who could take this qualification?

This Level 2 qualification is ideal if you're looking to gain an understanding of the warehousing and storage industry. Opportunities for further learning exist if you are looking to gain further knowledge, develop skills and take on more responsibility.

The Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage Principles (knowledge-based qualification) offers an opportunity for learning at level 2 outside of related employment or an apprenticeship programme, and so is ideal for those learners looking to expand their knowledge of Warehouse and Storage without having to be employed in the sector. The other Ofqual regulated qualifications in this sector are the Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage (501/1082/2) and Level 3 Diploma in Warehousing and Storage (600/3766/0). These combine knowledge and competence elements, for which the latter requires the learner to produce assessment evidence from a relevant position of employment.

#### WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

The learner could progress onto a Warehousing and Storage Apprenticeship at Level 2 or 3 or other qualifications such as:

- Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage (combined knowledge and competence)
- Level 3 Diploma in Warehousing and Storage (combined knowledge and competence)
- Level 3 Certificate in Logistics Operations Management
- Level 3 Certificate in Traffic Office
- Level 2 Certificate in International Trade and Logistics Operations
- Level 2 Award and Certificate in Fork Lift Truck Operations.

This qualification could lead to a wide range of jobs in warehousing and logistics, including:

- Stock controller
- Warehouse operative
- Import/export officer
- Warehouse general assistant
- Warehouse manager.
