Entry Level Diploma in Personal Progress (Entry 1) (500/6792/8)

OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

The Entry Level 1 Diploma in Personal Progress is a wide ranging qualification that allows learners working at Entry 1 or below to develop their skills needed to participate as citizens within the community.

This qualification includes skills for communication, reading and writing, mathematics, developing skills for independent living, developing skills for the workplace and engaging with the world around you.

Providers select a package of units appropriate to the needs of the individual learner.

Learners will be able to develop knowledge and/or skills which will assist them to move towards independence in life, learning and work.

This is a Framework qualification.

- Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification designed for?

There are no formal entry requirements for candidates undertaking the qualification. However, centres must ensure that candidates have the potential and opportunity to gain the qualification successfully.

The Entry Level 1 Diploma is designed to support a young person or adult with learning difficulties. The qualification helps the individual build knowledge and skills so that they can participate more fully in the community.



WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

- Will the qualification lead to employment, and if so, in which job role at which level?

The qualification is designed to support the personal growth of the individual and their ability to operate within the community, including in all work settings. As such the qualification supports the learner towards gaining employment in all industries and roles.

- Will the qualification support progression to further learning, if so, what to?

There are smaller versions of this qualification; an Award and a Certificate.

The learner and provider should decide which sized qualification is most appropriate to meet the learner's needs. There

are no mandatory units so the learner can select the units which are most relevant and build the qualification they require, this also means a learner can achieve the Award and then take more units, progressing onto the Certificate or further to this Diploma.

On completing the Diploma the learner can progress onto higher level qualifications such as:

- Entry Level Award in Employability Skills (Entry 2)
- A range of qualifications within the maths and English suite, eg:
 - Entry Level Award in Reading - Reading and Understanding the Meaning of Words (Entry 2)
 - Entry Level Award in Speaking and Listening - Speaking and Listening to Obtain Information (Entry 2)
 - Entry Level Award in Measure, Shape and Space - Weight, Capacity and Temperature (Entry 2)
