E2.W.1	<p>Use written words and phrases to record and present information with some awareness of the intended audience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has written comments that use words and phrases suitable for the audience correctly, to provide appropriate information about the chocolate, what they liked or did not like about the chocolate, what it tastes like, have they tried the chocolate before and would they buy it again. • Has used some written words and phrases suitable for the audience, information may be incomplete, some misuse of words/phrases or somewhat inappropriate for audience. • Some evidence of use of written words and phrases – content is minimal but some suitable words and phrases have been attempted. • Insufficient content/evidence to demonstrate correct use of written word and phrases. 	<p>3 marks</p> <p>2 marks</p> <p>1 mark</p> <p>0 marks</p>	2	<p>One mark deducted for somewhat inappropriate for audience “the prise is seen was a little to mutch’.
