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3. Give **two** reasons why people need to book a table for the weekend. **2 marks**

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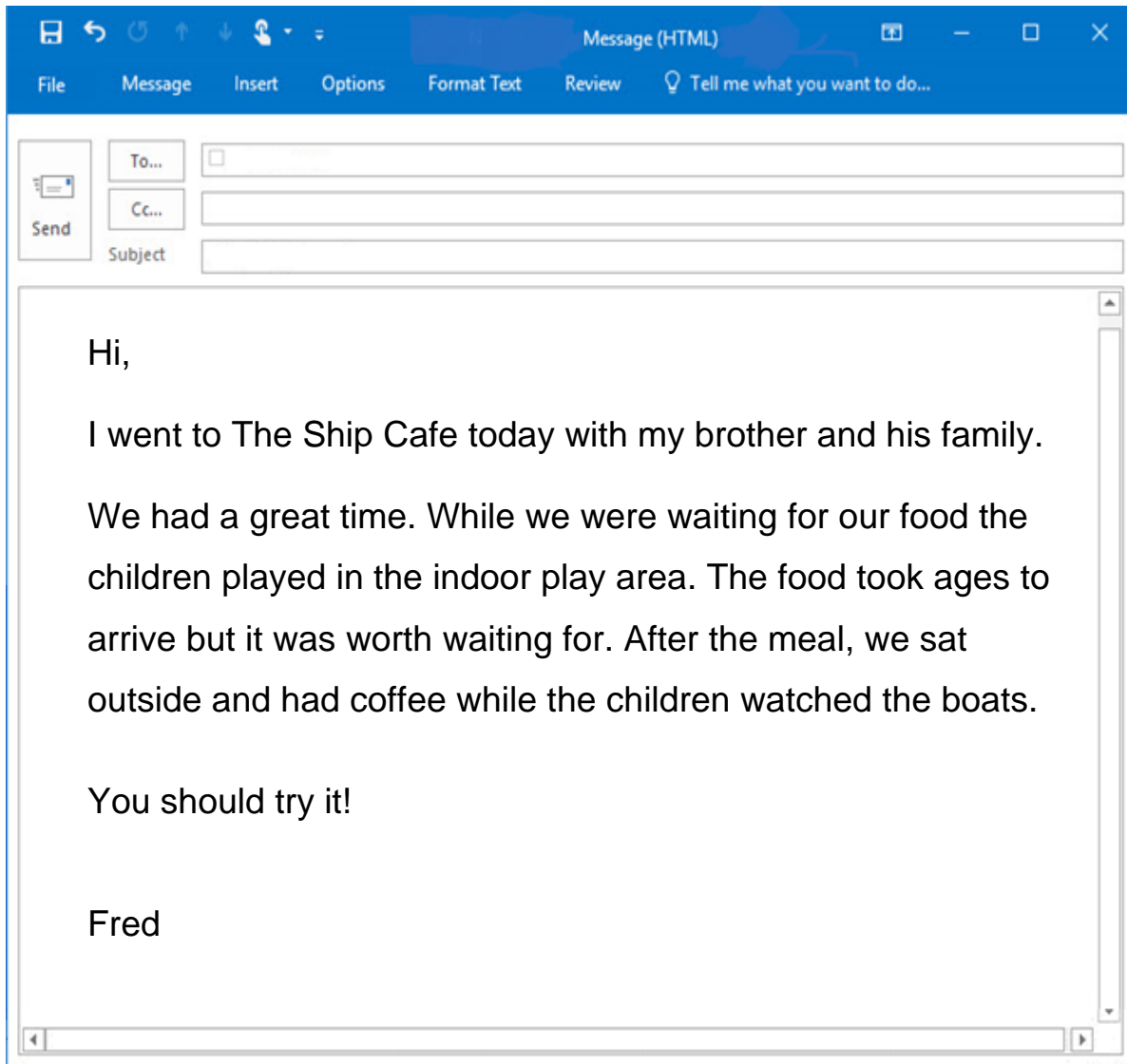
