Results Entry Entry level FS English	£12.50 per qualification	Payable only when claiming Certification/Grading module for Entry 1, 2 or 3 (see relevant pages of our Functional Skills qualifications handbook for details). Results Entry for individual FS English assessment components at Entry level is not charged. Please note candidates must be registered before accessing any live assessment material.
Named on Demand Entry (paper based/delivered assessments): FS Mathematics and FS ICT Levels 1 and 2	£16.00 per entry submitted	Fees are payable for each candidate and are charged when the entry is received. Assessments are on-demand and can be booked for any day/time (once the candidate has been registered), as long as at least 14 days' notice is given. This fee is described as On Demand .
Assessment Entry (on-screen – via e-volve) FS Mathematics and FS ICT Levels 1 and 2	£16.00 per assessment accessed	Fees are payable for each on-screen (e-volve) test taken (unlike paper based/delivered, there is no charge for absences), although are not charged until results are processed. Assessments are on- demand and can be scheduled at any time after the candidate has been registered. This fee is described as e-volve Test or e-volve Retest .
Results Entry FS English Speaking, Listening and Communication (SLC) Levels 1 and 2	Free	Result must be entered where the candidate has been successful in the SLC component, though is not charged; the Reading and Writing components must also be achieved (either paper-based or on-screen – see below) for certification.
		To claim qualification certification, the appropriate Certification module must also be submitted (see page 12 of our Functional Skills qualifications handbook for details).

Notes

Entry level assessments (and FS English Speaking, Listening and Communication at all levels) are externally set by City & Guilds, and marked internally by the centre. Assessment materials are downloaded from the **Functional Skills qualification webpage**.

The passwords for accessing the live Entry level material can be found on the relevant Walled Garden Catalogue page (ie 3748-01 for FS English, 3748-02 for FS Mathematics, 3748-03 for FS ICT). Candidates must be registered for the qualification **before** attempting any live assessments.

Paper-delivered Level 1-2 external assessments are booked using the **On Demand** function on the Walled Garden. Entries must be for named candidates. Onscreen Level 1-2 external assessments are delivered via the **e-volve** system and scheduled via the Walled Garden.
