501/0130/4 Level 1 Certificate in Tyre Fitting Principles

OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification is for learners looking to develop basic level skills and knowledge in replacing and repairing worn and damaged standard light vehicle tyres and commercial vehicle tyres.

The key skills learners will have acquired upon achievement of this qualification are:

- Working safety in a motor vehicle workshop.
- Inspect, fit, repair and maintain standard light vehicle tyres.
- Inspect, fit, repair and maintain tyres on medium and large commercial vehicles (3500kg gross vehicle mass and above).
Receive, record and store stock updating stock control systems
- Completing documentation in a dealership, fast fit centre, parts distribution centre or similar situation.

Other non-technical but essential skills also include how to maintain good working relationships with colleagues and customers in the automotive work environment by using effective communication and support.

This is a framework qualification.

- Who could take this qualification?

Although some learners may already have had some exposure to the motor vehicle industry via previous training or some practical experience, it is not necessary to hold any previous qualifications or being in a current work placement.

Learners will usually take this qualification at a college where they will have access to facilities, equipment and tools that will allow them to gain the skills and knowledge required to progress into further education and training or an intermediate level apprenticeship.



WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

Candidates who are successful will have the following progression opportunities available:

- Further training: by moving into either the Level 2 Diploma in Vehicle Fitting Principles (501/0748/3) or the Level 2 Diploma In Vehicle Specialist Tyre Fitting Principles (600/1449/0).
- Into employment – by taking up either a Level 2 Intermediate Apprenticeship in Vehicle Fitting - Fast Fit to become a Fast Fit Technician or a Level 2 Intermediate Apprenticeship in Vehicle Fitting – Specialist Tyre Fitting to become a Tyre Fitting Specialist.
