Re-development of Modern Apprenticeship frameworks for Body and Paint (Scotland)

Following review of the National Occupational Standards in Accident Repair we are redeveloping the following qualifications which will go live on 01 June 2018 to ensure a smooth transition from current frameworks to the new ones.

The new qualification numbers will be:

- 9422-56 Level 3 Modern Apprenticeship in Vehicle Body and Paint - Vehicle Paintwork Repair
- 4311-43 SVQ in Vehicle Body Repair & Alignment at SCQF Level 6
- 4311-53 SVQ 3 in Vehicle Paintwork Repair at SCQF Level 6
- 4391-42 Diploma in Vehicle Accident Repair Body Principles at SCQF Level 5
- 4391-52 Diploma in Vehicle Accident Repair Paint Principles at SCQF Level 5
- 4391-43 Diploma in Vehicle Body Repair & Alignment Principles at SCQF Level 6
- 4391-53 Diploma in Vehicle Accident Repair Paint Principles at SCQF Level 6
