Clarification on evidence collection in the new framework automotive qualifications.

We have been asked to clarify what evidence is acceptable in the new framework automotive qualifications, especially when delivering the VRQ and VCQ as part of an apprenticeship.

VCQ 4270: centres must have correct number of assessments, which should come from the workplace or some may come from recognised in-house assessments linked to awarding organisations quality control, linked to acceptable SSC requirements.

VRQ 4290: centres need to have the correct number of assessments; some or all may be taken from the VCQ 4270 if of the same assessment type. In cases where the VRQ has a greater number of observed assessments, these can be done by an assessor or competent witness either through: 1. in house (training or college centre)

2. extra observations in the workplace.

Invigilators' requirements for online tests.

Online tests cover the essential knowledge and understanding for each unit as set by the assessment strategy. They can be invigilated by a tutor/assessor that the candidate knows and do not require an independent invigilator.
